Overview of the Program:

Youth Leadership Logan is a program developed by the Logan County Chamber of Commerce that offers a vast array of community insight for individuals who desire to play a significant role in the development, growth, and activity of Logan County. To create community activism and involvement among the youth of the county, up to 10 Logan County High School and up to 10 Russellville High School sophomore students are invited to participate annually.

The Youth Leadership Logan program runs concurrently with the school year. Sessions are held on the third Thursday of each month (subject to change), August through April with no session in December. Eight all-day sessions deal with topics vital to our community: agriculture, tourism, history, education, small business, government, industry, human services, chamber, economic development, and the environment.

Students applying for inclusion in Youth Leadership Logan Program should be firm in their commitment to participation. Absenteeism will prevent the student from receiving the full educational benefits that the program provides. Strong participation will prepare students to become active in the affairs of the community, as well as allowing a student to share new, valuable perspectives with class members. It will be the student's responsibility to inform the proper school officials of the schedule of meetings in order to be excused from classes on those days.

Schools will be notified by Friday, May 12th of the selection for Youth Leadership Logan Program. Orientation will begin in August and sessions will begin in September. Students will complete the program in April 2024 with a graduation ceremony. School buses will transport students on Leadership days.

Criteria for Leadership Logan selection:

1. Must be a student with a cumulative GPA of 2.8 or above.
2. Must be a sophomore student during the 2023-2024 school year.
3. Must attend Logan County or Russellville High School.
4. The cost of the Program is \$125.00 per student and is covered IN FULL by the school if your child is chosen. This fee covers the student's meals, shirt, and program materials.
